## Father Kline's Corner

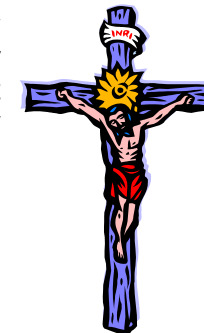
Parish Family,

It's hard to believe, but next weekend is Easter. Have you made your confession to prepare for Easter? If not, come **Monday to the Penance Service at 7pm** or at any other time confessions are available this coming Holy Week. (See the Holy Week schedule of events on the front of the bulletin).

The movie ***The Passion of the Christ*** will be played here at our Parish Center from **1:30pm to 3:35pm on Palm Sunday** also called "Passion Sunday". The weekend after Easter Sunday is **Divine Mercy Sunday**. It's the day Pope John Paul II and Pope John XXIII will be canonized. I have been asked to offer the **Divine Mercy Devotion at St. Francis of Assisi at 3pm**. Every year about 500 people attend. I am honored to be asked. You are welcome to come to the Mass at St. Francis in Wichita. Here at **Sacred Heart we will have a Holy Hour on Divine Mercy Sunday at 3pm**, led by Ruth Smith and Amy Gerber.

A **Novena leading up to Divine Mercy Sunday begins on Good Friday**. The Novena prayers are in the back of the church. You are encouraged to daily pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet. On Divine Mercy Sunday, Jesus told St. Faustina when we receive Holy Communion, our soul will be like it was at baptism, which means all venial sins and the punishment due to our sins is washed away in the ocean of God's mercy. All purgatory time we have accumulated during our life will be forgiven. There are conditions which are necessary to receive this once a year grace. One must have gone to Confession during Lent and receive Holy Communion during one of the Divine Mercy Masses on April 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> and one must be in the state of grace when receiving Holy Communion. We are to prepare for this grace by doing deeds of mercy, whether that is by prayer and or doing good deeds for others. As we celebrate Easter next weekend and welcome our new Catholics into our church, let us be glad and rejoice in God's infinite mercy. Who wants to spend years and years in purgatory? Let us take advantage of God's infinite mercy!
