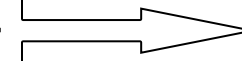

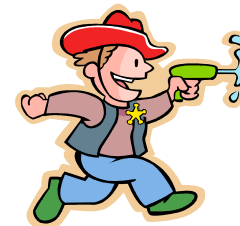
Father Kline's Corner



Parish Family,

You will notice the insert on **Prayer and Action**. It was truly a blessed three weeks with over **120 youth** participating and working on **28 different jobs**. If we see what God was doing through this event, we see the lives of many people being touched by love. The young people who came were touched by love through their prayer and the sacraments (Mass and Confession). They then took the love of Jesus and gave it to those to whom they helped and not only them but the communities in which they practiced stewardship. Stewardship as I have mentioned before is really discipleship. It's being a disciple of Jesus today. It's living out our baptismal commitment to go out and preach the Gospel (not only in words, but in actions). This event strengthened the already good reputation Sacred Heart has in the community. Will non-Catholics look at us and say, "I want to be like them."? There is something about love which cannot be contained and is contagious. There was a real out pouring of the Holy Spirit at a time in which our communities needed it. Youth from Halstead (who have now been arrested) had vandalized not only our church, but another church as well as the property of businesses and homeowners. Prayer & Action occurred during this sad time of evil and helped the local people to know not all youth are bad and in fact, the Catholic youth were great witnesses to the power of love, which countered the evil many experienced in Halstead. What are your gifts and talents and are you willing to share them out of love of God and neighbor?

We also have another youth event approaching (**Totus Tuus**), **July 20th thru 25th**. Last year about 40 of our youth attended. It is much more than the non-Catholic Vacation Bible



School. It's filled with all sorts of fun things and Catholic things to do. Singing, games, teachings, skits, Mass, Confession, and even a water gun fight on the last day of the retreat. **Totus Tuus** helps young people come to know that their faith can be fun. 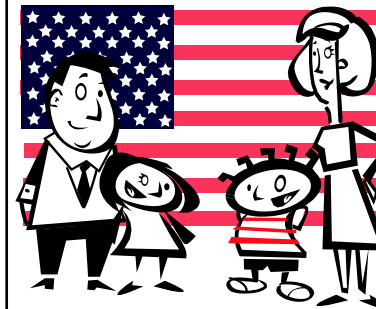

News from NBC: “The U.S. Supreme Court, in a limited decision, ruled Monday that closely held, for-profit companies can claim a religious exemption to the Obamacare requirement that they provide health insurance coverage for contraceptives. For-profit corporations—including Hobby Lobby had challenged a provision of the Affordable Care Act. The court’s ruling Monday was 5-4 written by Justice Samuel Alito, ... the ruling appeared to be a clear victory for the companies that brought the case and for perhaps 50-60 other companies like them with similar objections to the contraceptive requirement.”
