The Pastor's Corner

Parish Family,

In last week's bulletin I listed the names of those who were taking the RCIA classes. I made a mistake. Jerry Runnebaum actually received all the sacraments. He wanted to take the class as a support for his wife Diane, who desires to become Catholic.

Enclosed in this bulletin is a letter from the bishops of Kansas. Effective May 1st, Mass stipends will increase to \$10 throughout the state of Kansas. We must always remember, "that priests are to celebrate the Mass intentions of the faithful who approach them in good faith regardless of whether or not a stipend is offered." So how much do Mass stipends cost? The answer is nothing. People however out of the goodness of their heart developed the custom of giving money to the priest when they want a Mass offered in order help the priest with his persona expenses. Years ago, the money donated to the priest was the sole source of income. Today, however the priest is paid by the parish or in some cases by the diocese or institution such as nursing home or hospital or even convent. My current salary which is the same for all pastors in the diocese is \$2435 per month before taxes. As I noted in the past, most of my income goes back to the parish in some way, although I do have other charities and persons that I donate on a regular basis. Taxes, car insurance, gas, clothes, food, religious articles, books make up the majority of my personal expenses. My car has 245,000 miles and it keeps running like a top. The rest is given to God's people in some way or another. Pope Francis has shed light on the need for priests to live lives of poverty. St. Francis of Assisi is a good example for priests to follow. He wanted all of his friars to love "lady" poverty.

As you know I am hoping to go on a pilgrimage to Lourdes and Fatima in Sept. The trip is free for me. The priest goes free because he is expected and joyfully loves to offer the sacraments (Mass & Confession) and give spiritual direction to the pilgrims. I encourage you to think about going. There is one person from our parish who wants to go, but is hoping another person will go as well. Will it be you? Fr. Edmond Kline, pastor

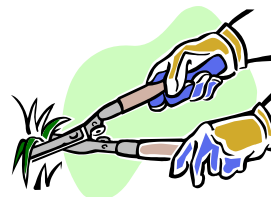
