## Lights for the Church

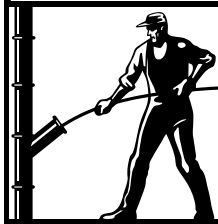

## Father Kline's Corner

Parish Family,

It never ceases to amaze me, how God is a God of surprises. As you know we began our Stewardship Council to help us begin, in a more formal way, the life of Stewardship in our parish. The good Lord continues to give us examples of good people, who inspire us to practice stewardship and He sends them in unexpected ways. Just when I thought we discovered everything to be repaired, more is discovered. During the rain, (thanks be to God for the rain), it was noticed the roof leaks into the Adoration Chapel. While looking at the roof, I noticed holes in the outdoor stucco of the parish center, most likely caused by hail. Wray Roofing is expected to do the roofing repairs. Also with the nice rain, came another discovery, the outdoor drain (near the door to the basement of the church) was plugged and began to flood the basement of the church.

Since Stith Heating/Air and Plumbing Service came to repair a leaking facet in the maintenance room of the Parish Center, a valve assembly in a toilet of the rectory and adjust the water fountain, because water was over shooting past the drain and onto the floor, I also asked them to repair the drain, but they recommended we contact Star Drain. Star Drain discovered the drain was plugged due to roots and a broken underground line. Because the line was broken due to roots, their snake became caught in the drainage line and is still in the line, so **please avoid the entrance**



## to the basement of the church.

Star Drain is run by non-Catholic Christians. They don't charge churches for their services. They do it as their stewardship. Their stewardship saved Sacred Heart nearly \$500. The drain now partially works, but the broken line needs to be repaired and the snake needs to be retrieved. Brand Plumbing, run by a father whose son will be ordained a priest next week, is expected to repair the broken line.

By the way, Stith came out to give us an estimate for the central air unit, which was replaced by Fisher Heating and Air. Sith never charged us for coming out twice. This was their stewardship as well. Let us pray for those who have been so kind and generous in giving their time and talent for the Lord and may their example help us to live more deeply the Stewardship way of life. Be sure to read the Stewardship insert and plan to come to the Parish Feast Day Celebration. We will have a sign-up next weekend, so as to know how much food to prepare. Ya'll come now—ya hear! Fr.
