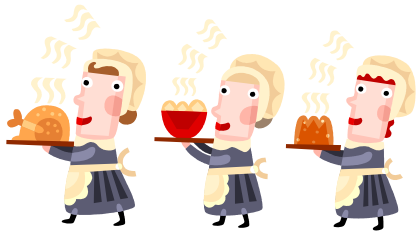


PARISH NEWS

NOVENA TO CLOSE THE WICHITA ABORTION CLINIC DEC. 4TH TO DEC. 12TH

From Dec. 4th thru Dec. 12th (*Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe*), there will be a 9-Day Novena to Close the Abortion Clinic in Wichita. Did you know the ordinary pill and IUD can cause the death of an unborn child? Within 5 days of conception, contraceptives prevent a fetus from attaching to the mother's womb. The mother loses her child and she didn't even know she was pregnant.
