Stewardship - Faith in Action

This week Sacred Heart received a very generous donation of \$65,000 for the purchase of the house located at 316 W. 5th St., south of the Parish Center near the alley behind the church.

It was on Sept.. 22nd, when Gene Wendling came to the Pastoral Council meeting and spoke about his gift. He began by explaining that his family helped start Sacred Heart parish. Because Gene is 90+ years young, he said he has seen every pastor since Sacred Heart was declared a parish. He mentioned that he believed there shouldn't be any strings attached to a gift and there would not be any with this one. However, he shared some of his ideas for which the house could be used.

He said the donation was in memory of his family, who helped found Sacred Heart, but especially his beloved wife, Marcy, who died in 2003. The Wendling Family homesteaded their farm in 1874 and it was in 1884, (130 years ago) when the first church of Sacred Heart was erected and began to have Masses, though not yet declared a parish.

Let us give thanks to Gene for his example of stewardship and keep him in our prayers. May God reward him for sharing this wonderful gift, which will assist future generations of our parish family of Sacred Heart. Thank you Gene for your BIG Heart in imitation of the Sacred Heart of Jesus!
