Weekend Mass Schedule: Saturday 5:30pm & Sunday 8:30am and 11:00am

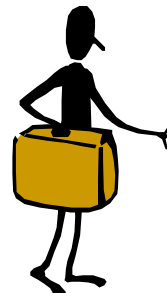
