The Missionaries of Our Lady of La Salette

will preach the annual parish mission appeal on Sept. 25 & 26th. We welcome Fr. Philip Aung, M.S., to Sacred Heart Church. Fr. Philip is from Myanmar (Burma). After his studies in the Philippines and doing ministry there for a year, Fr. Philip along with four other Myanmar national priests were able to re-open the mission in his country. Our La Salette Missionaries (all Americans) had opened the mission in 1937 and were expelled by the communist military dictatorship in 1976. Two years ago our native Missionaries returned - welcomed by the Church and the people but still suspect by the military dictatorship. Fr. Philip now serves as the Director of the La Salette Missions in Myanmar. The Missionaries of Our Lady of La Salette minister to people of every race, language, culture and way of life—beginning at the La Salette Shrine in France where our Blessed Mother appeared in 1846.

"Once One Chooses to be a Disciple of Christ, Stewardship is not an Option"

Would that all the people of the Lord were prophets! Today's readings remind us that God's call to service reaches beyond our human understanding. Moses told Joshua that it was the message of God that was important, not the messenger. Jesus had to explain the same thing to his disciples – do not restrict those who are proclaiming the Gospel and spreading the Love of God. In support of heeding the Word of God, St. James warns the people that earthly pleasures and treasures will fade away and that we should be working for life in heaven. May our understanding of Jesus' Gospel lead us to live as good stewards of God's gifts.
