Ash Wednesday, February 18th and Good Friday, April 3rd, are days of FASTING. Catholics, from the 18th birthday up to the 59th birthday ARE OBLIGATED TO FAST that is, take only one full meal and two lesser meals, with nothing to eat in between meals. Drinking fluids would not be contrary to the practice of fasting. Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent, including Good Friday, are days of ABSTAINING from meat. All Catholics, beginning with the 14th birthday, ARE OBLIGATED TO ABSTAIN from eating meat.
