Parish Hall Roof Needs Replacement

We recently discovered our Parish Hall Roof (GYM roof) needs a total replacement. It was first put on in 1983, when the Parish Center was built. Its a flat roof and flat roofs need total replacement on occasion. We were able to get 32 years out of the current roof and it has had multiple repairs over the years. We are going to make some immediate minor repairs to hold us over until we can get the roof repaired. The Pastoral Council, Finance Council and I are working toward this effort. Flat roofs usually last at the most 25 years. If you or any of the parish organizations are interested in helping to pay for a new roof, let me know. We are currently in the process of getting quotes. We do have enough in savings to pay for the roof, but it will deplete a good chunk of our savings. Your regular tithing will help and especially your prayers are appreciated.
