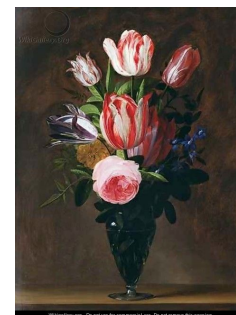

NEW PLAN FOR ALTAR FLOWERS



There is a sign up poster in the back of church for the altar flowers. Parishioners are encouraged to sign up to provide flowers throughout the year. You can sign up more than once. Flowers need to be on the Main Altar following Saturday morning Mass & will remain until the following Saturday. Vases are in the north sacristy (the door to the right of the Altar) in the metal cabinet. If the flowers are still nice from the previous week, they can be moved to the side altars or to the Adoration Chapel.

You are not responsible to water them throughout the week.
