Those who go to Confession during Lent and receive the Eucharist in the state of grace (no mortal sins on one's soul), will have all their sins and the punishment due to their sins washed away in the ocean of God's mercy on Divine Mercy Sunday. Our soul will become like it was at baptism. Sacred Heart will have a Divine Mercy Holy Hour from 3pm to 4pm, the Sunday after Easter, April 12th.
