Grace

Grace is favor. It is the free and undeserved help that God gives us to respond to His call to become children of God, adoptive sons, partakers of the divine nature and of eternal life. Grace is the love and mercy given to us by God because God desires us to have it, not because we have necessarily done anything to earn it.

The Catholic Church teaches that it is because of the action of Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit in transforming into the divine life what is subjected to God's power that "the sacraments confer the grace they signify." The power of Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit acts in and through each sacrament independently of the personal holiness of the minister. At the same time, the fruits of the sacraments also depend upon the disposition of the one who receives them.

In other words, we must constantly pray for an increase in the virtue of faith! Christ demands this of us. The more we desire to reap the fruits of the sacraments, especially the Eucharist, the more we must beg God for greater faith. We cannot take our faith for granted, lest we run the risk of God taking it away!
