### Palm Sunday

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week and Jesus' final journey to His crucifixion. It gives us an opportunity to reflect on the final week of Jesus' life. We focus more acutely on the fact that Jesus came in the flesh as a suffering servant to save mankind, not an earthly king. Christ humbly enters into Jerusalem to give His life on the cross.

Palm branches were a Jewish symbol of triumph and victory (Leviticus 23:40; Revelation 7:9). Near East tradition involved covering the path of someone who held a high place of honor. On this day Christ is given a similar honor as the crowds chant: "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest! (Matthew 21:8).

During Holy Week the Catholic Church also celebrates the Chrism Mass. During this Mass the Bishop blesses the oils to be used throughout the year for baptisms and anointings. Also during this Mass priests renew their priestly vows before the Bishop and the congregation. You may consider attending the Chrism Mass if you have never previously experienced it.

The Easter Triduum begins with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday evening and concludes with Mass of all Masses-the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday evening. Palm Sunday invites us to prepare our hearts for the agony of Christ's Passion in order to be able to share in the joy of His Resurrection!
