The Truth

The following thoughts are taken from Shane Schaezel's blog "Catholics Are Christian."

Papal "infallibility" is restricted to decrees made by the pope ex cathedra "from the chair." This means that a pope has to specifically teach something, limited to faith and or morals, and specifically invoke his office as the Successor of Saint Peter, and specifically say that this particular decree is to be held as infallible (without error). If he doesn't do all of these things, then the teaching could potentially contain error. In most cases, it probably doesn't, but it is possible that in some cases it might. In other words, unless he has made the decree ex cathedra, it is possible (however rare) that the pope could be wrong.

Only two popes, namely Pius XII and John Paul II, have exercised the ex cathedra dogma of infallibility (outside of the canonization of saints). Pius XII proclaimed the Dogma of the Blessed Virgin Mary's Assumption in 1950. John Paul II infallibly proclaimed in 1994 that no member of the hierarchy (not even the pope) has the authority to ordain women to the priesthood.

This means that the pope can err on matters of faith and morals when he is not speaking ex cathedra. He is only infallible when speaking ex cathedra, which is very rare. Therefore the pope is not necessarily free from error every time he officially speaks.
