Why spend a holy hour?

Saint John Paul II has said that the Church and the world have a great need of Eucharistic adoration. "Let us be generous with our time in going to meet Jesus and ready to make reparation for the great evils of the world. Let your adoration never cease." (Saint John Paul II, *Dominicae Cenae*)

Our Lord Jesus Christ wants you to do more than go to Mass on Sunday.
