Divine Mercy

“Repent and believe in the Gospel” (Lk. 1:15). These are the first words that Our Lord addressed to mankind. This is the same message Our Lady of Fatima conveyed to the world when she exhorted us to conversion and repentance over one hundred years ago. God's merciful love is greater than all sin. It is greater than all evil and greater than death itself. In fact, mercy is the greatest attribute of God. No matter what we have done God wants us to repent and turn to His mercy with trust!

Our Lord said to St. Faustina: “No soul will be justified until it turns with confidence to My mercy and this is why the first Sunday after Easter is to be the Feast of Mercy...” Our Lord also told St. Faustina that whoever will recite the Chaplet of Divine Mercy will receive great mercy at the hour of death. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy...
