The Love of Evil

The Catholic Church is vastly shrinking in her numbers. When the Church is shrinking this means the world is winning in the fight against evil. Why? Because the world loves its sin along with many members of Holy Mother Church herself. The Church has decided she must cooperate, dialogue, and never give “offense” to anyone. As a result we have much silence in the face of blatant evil. The world loves its immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, pornography, rampant sex...But we shouldn't be surprised.
