## Salvation

As Our Lord travelled through cities, villages and on to Jerusalem, One said to him, "Lord are they few who are saved?" St. Luke reminds us again that Jesus is on his way to Jerusalem, where he will die. Jesus says: "Strive to enter in by the narrow door, for many, I tell you, will seek to enter in, and will not be able. When once the master of the house has risen up, and has shut the door, and you begin to stand outside, and to knock at the door, saying, "Lord, Lord, open to us!" then he will answer and tell you, I don't know you or where you came from. Then you will begin to say, "We ate and drank in your presence, and you taught in our streets." He will say, I tell you, I don't know where you came from. Depart from me, all you workers of iniquity."

Our Lord answers by saying the door to salvation is narrow, but does allow admittance to the spiritually fit. He uses the word "strive." St. Paul also use this word to speak of competition (1Cor. 9:25), training intensively in Godliness (1Tim. 4:10), and fighting the good fight (1Tim. 6:12). While salvation is a gift from God, it is clear that God expects us to cherish it as an athlete cherishes the victor's crown-suggesting that we need an athlete's discipline and determination in pursuing entrance through the narrow door.
