First Sunday of Advent

The First Sunday of Advent (Fourth before Christmas) marks the beginning of a brand new “Liturgical Year.” The Holy Mass helps to prepare us for the twofold coming (adventus) of mercy and justice. Thus, Saint Paul tells us to do away with sin so that we may be ready for the coming of Our Lord Jesus Christ as our Savior. However, we must also prepare for His coming as our Judge. We can do so through persistent prayer, sacrifice and penance. We must beg Our Lord for the grace of conversion and the amendment of our lives. Our Lord promises to reward those who long for His coming and who do so with faith and confidence. If we trust in Our Savior we shall not be confounded...
