Advent

Beginning the Church's liturgical year, Advent (from, “ad-venire” in Latin or “to come to”) is the season encompassing the four Sundays (and weekdays) leading up to the celebration of Christmas. The Advent season is a time of preparation that directs our hearts and minds to Christ's second coming at the end of time and also to the anniversary of the Lord's birth on Christmas. The final days of Advent, from December 17 to December 24, focus particularly on our preparation for the celebrations of the Nativity of our Lord (Christmas).

According to the Code of Canon Law: Can. 1250 The penitential days and times in the universal Church are every Friday of the whole year and the season of Lent. Therefore, according to Canon Law, Advent is not a penitential season. However, since we are preparing for Christ's coming as our judge, it is certainly proper and acceptable (even necessary) to do penance during the Advent season. In fact, we are called to be a penitential people all our days!

Remember that the Church's traditions are not comprehensively determined by or summed up in any Code of Canon Law, nor in any Missal or other liturgical book. It is true, for example, that Advent is not a fasting season.
