Active Participation at Mass

“Mother Church earnestly desires that all the faithful should be led to that fully conscious, and active participation in liturgical celebrations which is demanded by the very nature of the liturgy” (Sacrosanctum Concilium, 14). However, active participation does not refer to external activity. The Mass is where “heaven meets earth” and we are made present on Mount Calvary to witness the sacrifice of Christ on the cross. At Mass we do more than simply remember a past event. The Holy Sacrifice is the re-presentation of an action that had eternal consequences.

The Mass is truly divine in nature, therefore it is always about God and not us. Active participation in the Mass then means that we must strive to unite our hearts and minds fully to God interiorly. Active participation technically does not require any external act by the faithful. What matters is that we are spiritually present and not focused on anything else except Christ's sacrifice. This means that if one is physically present at Mass, one's heart must not be elsewhere!

True active participation thus refers to a “contemplatively engaged participation in the saving work of our redemption.” It is interior before it is exterior.
