The Catholic Faith

Since Our Lord Jesus Christ founded our holy religion, one of its great beauties is its pure simplicity. We are called to be pure and simple as well. We must have a certain “single mindedness” of wanting Heaven and nothing else. We must love God above all things and with all our hearts just like the Blessed Virgin Mary.

A great first-step in showing our love for God is acknowledging His true presence in the Blessed Sacrament which He instituted. Jesus Christ is truly and substantially present-Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity in the consecrated host. Our Lord has commanded us to eat His Body and drink His Blood-pure and simple. But we must do so with pure hearts and minds. We must never consume the host while in a state of mortal sin.

We must always be in a state of sanctifying grace in order to receive the Holy Eucharist. This is another simple teaching of the Church. God is life itself. We cannot receive the author of life into a soul that is lifeless. A person in a state of mortal sin has a soul without life. The only way to get that life back is to make a sacramental confession to a priest.

If we truly love Our Lord we will live a life clinging to His commandments. This is a choice that when we make it now and live it now, it will be ratified for eternity. The Son of God commanded us to eat His Body and drink His Blood, without which we have no life in us. We must make the right choice now, before we die if we expect to inherit eternal life!
