What draws people to the Traditional Latin Mass?

The features which draw Catholics to the Traditional Latin Mass are threefold: silence, the use of Latin, and the orientation of the priest. Last week we addressed the value of silence at the Holy Sacrifice. Here we will focus on the use of the Latin language.

The use of Latin, a language which no longer changes in meaning, allows the meaning of the sacred words of the Mass to remain unchanged through time. “Everyone, past, present, and future will be able to feast on the self-same truths which Our Lord Jesus Christ gave us.” This universality and doctrinal precision are not the only reasons for the use of Latin, however. Paradoxically, its incomprehensibility speaks eloquently of the mystery and transcendence of God. The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is like no other action on earth, and the use of Latin, “the province of the sacred and the property of the Divinity, allows the faithful to understand everything about the love God has for them and about the love they should have for Him, a love which transcends everything ordinary on earth.”

Saint John Paul II often emphasized that Latin remains the official language of the Catholic Church. He often expressed his desire that the love of the language would grow ever strong among both the laity as well as candidates for the priesthood...
