Traditional Latin Mass

People are attracted to the Traditional Latin Mass mainly because it offers silence, the use of the Latin language and the priest and the people face the same way. Many people, including some bishops and priests, say it doesn't really matter which direction the priest faces. But when the priest faces the same direction as the people during the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass he is very clearly leading them before the throne of God. The priest is the people's representative before an awesome and objective reality. He stands in the gap, offering sacrifices for his own sins as well as for those of the people. This is something that simply cannot be done without the priest. He is leading you towards heaven!

Furthermore, the entire congregation is oriented toward someone, namely, Jesus Christ, who is substantially present in the tabernacle. Thus, it is very clear that the real audience of the Mass is Jesus Christ, and not the people. When the priest faces the people, however, it turns the whole Mass inward, towards us, and toward our subjective feelings and experience of God. It turns and objective and transcendent reality into a self-referential act!

When the priest faces the people he becomes a performer for their observation. Their sense of participation is wholly dependent upon whether or not they can “see” what is going on. The Mass no longer becomes a march towards heaven, but rather it becomes solely about the people and their feeling of community and “belonging.” What matters is that the people and the priest look together at our Lord Jesus Christ while facing the same way.

In Christ, Fr. Jeff Fasching
