The wedding feast at Cana

When we pick up the Holy Rosary and we come to the second luminous mystery, we meditate on the first public miracle Our Lord performed by changing the water into wine. Christ did this simply because His mother asked Him to do it. As His mother, Christ cannot refuse anything she asks of Him. This is why it is so vital that we choose to offer our prayers to God the Father through His Blessed Mother. She is our most powerful intercessor. She is our most powerful advocate. The Blessed Virgin Mary is the refuge of sinners. She exists to constantly intercede for us.

When we meditate upon this particular mystery of the Holy Rosary we should ask God for the grace to rely upon the Blessed Virgin for all our needs! God has no absolute need of the Blessed Virgin Mary. She is a mere creature and nothing in comparison to Him. However, God has willed to begin and end His greatest works by the Most Holy Virgin. We can rest assured His sentiments and conduct will not change.

As Saint Louis de Montfort explains, "If then the knowledge and the kingdom of Jesus Christ are to come into the world, they will be but a necessary consequence of the knowledge and the kingdom of the most holy Virgin Mary, who brought Him into the world for the first time, and will make His second advent full of splendor..."
