The Real Presence

The real presence of Jesus Christ in the tabernacle is certainly a Divine Mystery. When the words of consecration are pronounced, “This is My Body...This is the chalice of My Blood” (Mt. 26:26-27), the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ! Jesus says: “My Flesh is real food and My Blood is real drink” (Jn. 6:56).

Christ is truly hidden in the Host and within the chalice in His Divine Person, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity. He also remains continually in the consecrated Hosts reserved in the tabernacle. He does this because of His infinite love for us and His desire to remain with us in a very literal way. We should strive to foster a regular habit of visiting Christ in the tabernacle.

The saints certainly all knew where Jesus was, and they desired the privilege of keeping watch with Him, especially by their bodily presence. Being with our beloved is one of the most important demands of true love. How much do you love Jesus Christ?
