Holiness

Jesus said: “Be you therefore perfect, as also your heavenly Father is perfect” (Mt. 5:48). With this statement Our Lord turns our attention to God's infinite perfection. Although the human mind is incapable of embracing and comprehending the infinite, our ideas of God tell us something about Him and His infinite perfections. Still, we cannot know God as He really is. St. Paul thus says God “inhabits light inaccessible” (1Tim. 6:16). This light infinitely exceeds the capacity of the human intellect. It is a light too bright and dazzling to be gazed at directly by the eye of our mind.

However, Our Lord also taught us to raise our eyes to these heights. He taught us that the little we can understand about them will be of great value to us. The more a soul therefore advances toward God, the more it understands that what it knows about Him is nothing compared with what He is in reality. Only in heaven shall we be able to see the divinity face to face.

We should be mindful how we err when we become attached to any creature. No matter how beautiful, good, or wise it may be, its goodness, beauty, and wisdom are nothing in comparison with the perfections of God. The soul that sets its heart on the good things of the world is supremely evil in the eyes of God. If we wish to unite ourselves to God, we cannot allow our heart to be held by the beauty or good qualities of any creature. We must place our affection and our hope in God alone!
