Going to the heart of all the evil in the Church is the betrayal of Christ's true presence in the Blessed Sacrament. This was the betrayal of Judas, it was the betrayal of all the Protestant revolutionaries and it is also the betrayal of the many modernists in the Church today. However, we know and believe that Jesus Christ is truly and substantially present under the appearance of bread and wine.

Our Blessed Lord Jesus Christ offered Himself as a sacrifice on the Cross-He offered His very flesh to be perpetuated throughout time-not a new and different sacrifice each time, but the same sacrifice continued, once for all. Why does Our Lord desire that His once-for-all Sacrifice be spread through history, accessible to each person? Because just as He commanded the Israelites to eat the sacrifice as a foreshadowing of Holy Communion, so too He commanded His followers to eat the sacrifice, which was and is His very flesh!

Remember when the Jews at Capernaum pleaded with Him to give them this bread always, He replied, "The bread that I will give is My flesh for the life of the world." Christ offered Himself on the Cross so that from that time onward, all His followers could eat the flesh of their sacrificial lamb, just as was done during that first Passover in Egypt.

The point is that the lamb must be eaten or the sacrifice is not complete. This is why Our Lord told the rabble around Him: "Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man, and drink His blood, you have no life in you." This became the single doctrine they refused to accept. And notice, it only took one for them to abandon Him, and in the case of Judas, to betray Him.
