Could you not watch one hour with Me?

Jesus Christ waits for us in the Blessed Sacrament. He loves when we offer Him our acts of faith, love, thanksgiving, repentance, reparation, charity and adoration as we place ourselves before His Divine Majesty in the Blessed Sacrament. According to St. Alphonsus Liguori: "Of all devotions, that of adoring Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament is the greatest after the Sacraments, the one dearest to God and the one most helpful to us." Praying before the Holy Eucharist outside of Mass places us face-to-face with the very wellsprings of grace...

We grow spiritually with each moment we spend with Jesus Christ! Through adoration of the Blessed Sacrament Christ calls us to an intimate, personal relationship with Him. He promises that all those who remain tightly bonded to Him will bear much fruit and "their joy will be complete." Without Him, we can do nothing!

St. John Vianney reminds us that if we really love God, we should make it our joy to adore Him in the Blessed Sacrament. We should regard those moments as the happiest of our lives...The Blessed Sacrament is the Living Fountain of Life where we "drink" in the love of Christ Who alone can quench our thirst. Nothing created is capable of satisfying us. Only God, Who is un-created, can do so!
