Corpus Christi

There has never been, nor will there ever be, a nobler or more magnanimous love than that which God has shown us in the Sacrament of His love. Nothing here on earth or in heaven can be compared to it. We are so very fortunate to have Jesus Christ in the Blessed Sacrament of the Altar! No friend or friends that we may have can ever do what Christ has done for us in making Himself present in the Holy Eucharist. It is His greatest miracle.

We should look upon the Blessed Sacrament as the stimulus for us all. Christ is present in the tabernacle in a way that He is not present anywhere else. He is present supernaturally and sacramentally, in His physical substance, under the ordinary and unexciting appearance of bread!

When we place ourselves before the Blessed Sacrament we give ourselves a profound opportunity to listen to God and have Him listen to us. When we are still and silent we begin to actually hear God listen and we become more aware of His presence in our lives.

Christ is present to us spiritually, tangibly, visibly, and sacramentally in the Holy Eucharist. We can receive Him and visit Him as often as we wish. Sitting in front of the Blessed Sacrament helps our souls become more beautiful and a beautiful spirit will help manifest in the body a more pleasing countenance. It brings rest to our souls. Remember the words of Christ: "Come, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest."
