Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus

This weekend (Friday) we celebrate our parish feast day. The Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus may be called the feast of His love for us. "Behold this Heart which has so loved men," Jesus said to St. Margaret Mary. The Heart of Our Lord Jesus Christ is always living in the Holy Eucharist to satisfy all our needs if we long for Him. When we become sad or disillusioned by day-to-day life we can always take refuge in the Heart of Jesus. "Take up My yoke upon you and learn of Me, because I am meek and humble of heart, and you shall find rest for your souls." The Heart of Jesus Christ is always a source of repose for our weary souls.

Remember the object of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is actually the physical Heart of Jesus, which is always worthy of adoration. However, the ultimate object of this devotion is the love of Jesus Christ, and His Heart is the symbol of this love. Pius VI states: "Beneath the symbolic image of the Heart, we contemplate and venerate our Divine Redeemer's immense charity and generous love."
