Mercy

When they tore His Body during the flagellation, when they crowned His head with thorns, when they spat upon His holy face, He saw us come forward to strike Him, to heap contempt upon Him and to cast our abominable sins in His face! And on the Cross, covered with blood and wounds, in an agony of grief and shame, He followed us with His glance, hoping that, like the prodigal son, in the end we would throw ourselves at His feet.

Jesus Christ leaves the ninety-nine faithful sheep and He follows us in our thoughtless course across the abyss of sin, hoping one day to catch up with us and to touch our hearts and bring us back to the fold. Does a Father not have the right to sigh for the return of his prodigal son? Who can blame him if each day with anxious glances he scans the horizon in the hope of seeing his son on the road home?!

If we would only give our hearts to God here and now! He will make sweet the thought of death by the remembrance of His Mother at the foot of the Cross, through the merits of His own agony on Calvary...and our very ashes will glorify God! Remember, Christ will come at an hour when we least expect Him. Just as a thief at night catches his victim off guard, so death will throw himself upon us without a word of warning and take away our lives.

Lent reminds us to be vigilant. We must pray and do penance while we can.
