Guidelines for Resuming of Public Masses

As instructed by Bishop Kemme

MASS PROTOCOL WILL BE AS FOLLOWS

- Each mass is limited to no more than 33% of the occupancy of the church.
- Upon entering the church please use the hand sanitizer provided. Masks are encouraged.
- Place your collection envelope/donation in the box at the back of church. There will not be an offertory procession or passing of the collection basket.
- Fill the church from the front to the back. If available, Ushers will assist with seating.
- Maintain a three person limit to each pew (unless seated together with family) Pews are marked with yellow tape at six foot intervals.
- Maintain six feet social distancing at ALL times. There are markers on the floor to assist with this when going to communion.
- Communion may be taken on the tongue or in the hand.
- At the conclusion of Mass, Please remain in your pew until the persons behind you have vacated and you can safely exit while maintaining the six feet distance. If available, Ushers will assist with this.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Please refrain from socializing in the church and outside before and after Mass.
- There will be no music sung during Mass.
- There will be no Servers, Lectors, Greeters, Gift Bearers, or Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion until further notice.
- The Rosary will not be prayed aloud before Mass.
- Please refrain from raising the kneelers till Father has left the Altar.
- The church will be disinfected after every Mass
