**Prayer**

Saint Thomas Aquinas describes certain conditions necessary to render prayer efficacious. First, prayer must proceed from charity, and since prayer is a lifting up of the heart and mind to God, it must have God as its end. Since charity is the virtue in the will which makes it possible to love God, then charity directs us to God.

The person praying must also have the requisite virtues, two of which Saint Thomas names: humility and faith. Humility is necessary because we must recognize our unworthiness. Faith is necessary in order for us to know who and what God is, so that we act rightly. Here the principle of *lex orandi, lex credendi* (it is prayer that leads to belief), plays a key role. Saint Thomas also says that prayers must be offered to God with devotion and attention. Finally, for the prayer to be meritorious, the person must be in a state of grace.

Prayer is our duty toward God. We are called to pray and to love.
