

## Pentecost

The word pentecost is derived from the Greek word “pentecoste,” meaning 50th. Pentecost always occurs 50 days after the death and resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ and ten days after His ascension. We celebrate the Descent of the Holy Ghost upon the Apostles and Mary, who were gathered together in the upper room.

At pentecost the Apostles received the gifts necessary to fulfill the mission Our Lord had prepared them for-to go out and preach His doctrine to all nations. It was right after pentecost that Saint Peter preached his first sermon to the Jews and other non-believers, showing how the Old Testament prophet Joel prophesied the events currently coming to fruition.

Saint Peter told the people that Jesus Christ whom they crucified was raised from the dead. The scripture tells us this “cut them to the heart.” Peter then exhorted them to repent of their sins and be baptized. The Acts of the Apostles tells us about 3,000 people were baptized following Peter's sermon.

This is why Pentecost is considered the birthday of the Church. Saint Peter was made the first Pope by Our Lord, and through his preaching thousands of non-believers were converted. We all share in the same mission of evangelization.
