God is the God of Peace

True love only resides in peace. We should thus always be careful to conserve the holy tranquility of heart that God offers us. When we experience anxiety or agitation in any way we can be sure these feelings do not come from God. God is the Prince of Peace. Adverse feelings are temptations of the evil one. We must therefore reject them.

We are called to everywhere and in everything live peacefully. When pain comes our way we must receive it peacefully. If we experience joy we should receive it peacefully as well.
