The Resurrection of the Dead

“Preserve my life according to your steadfast promise” (Psalm 119). God is a life-giver. He raises us to new life both in this life and the next. Our Lord says: “I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly” (John 10:10). “I am the way, and the truth, and the life” (John 14:6). Our Lord also says: “For God so loved the world that He gave us His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life” (John 3:16).

This belief in eternal life acts as the foundation of our hope in this life – a hope that provides courage and endurance. This is what we see in the story of the brothers that we read in the second book of Maccabees. They are not afraid to be killed because of their belief in a life beyond death. They are able to endure suffering because their faith provides meaning and purpose.

Our own faith should do the same for use. This life is really only a means to an end. All we do in this life should be preparing us for our eternal home. Faith helps us to sacrifice now so we can be certain of our heavenly reward.
