**Constitutional Amendment Petition**

Please sign the petition in the back of church. On April 26th, 2019, the Kansas Supreme Court created a nearly unlimited "right" to abortion in the 1859 Kansas Constitution and continued to allow the live dismemberment of unborn children in our state. Kansans have lost the right to ban even the most horrific practices like partial-birth and taxpayer-funded abortions. Therefore, we urge you to sign the petition calling for the Kansans Legislature to pass an amendment to the Kansas Constitution that reverses the Court's ruling and declares there is no unlimited "right" to abortion in our state. If approved by the legislature, the Amendment will be subject to a public vote at a scheduled election.

**Christ the King**

St. Paul exhorts us to always give thanks to the Father because God has, by His sheer grace and mercy, made us fit to share in the inheritance of the saints. God did this through His only begotten Son, Who shed His Precious Blood on the holy cross in order to allow us to have access to heaven! God has delivered us from the power of darkness and the evil influence of Satan. He has allowed us to become sharers in the kingdom of His beloved Son. It is in only in Christ that we have redemption and the forgiveness of our sins.
