The True Presence

Our Lord Jesus Christ is present in the tabernacle for our sakes as food for our souls. "My Flesh is food indeed and My Blood is drink indeed" (Jn. 6:56). We must receive the Body and Blood of Our Lord in order to nourish ourselves spiritually. Jesus says: "Amen, amen I say to you, unless you eat the Flesh of the Son of Man and drink His Blood, you shall not have life in you" (Jn. 6:54). St. Peter Julian Eymard has said: "Communion is as necessary for us to sustain our Christian vitality as the vision of God is necessary to the angels to maintain their life of glory."

We need to nourish our souls every day in the the same way we must nourish our bodies in order to maintain physical vitality. "We must take this Bread as we do ordinary bread when nourishing our bodies" (St. Charles Borromeo). Christ longs to be received into our hearts through Holy Communion. We can be sure that Satan does all he can to keep us away. We must not allow ourselves to be deceived. "Endeavor not to miss any Holy Communion, we can scarcely give our enemy, the devil, greater joy than when we withdraw from Jesus, who takes away the power the enemy has over us" (St. Margaret Mary Alacoque).
