Prayer

Throughout the Gospels Our Lord was explicit regarding the need for both public and private prayer. Jesus often withdrew by Himself to pray in a quiet place. He prayed to revive Himself after long periods of serving others. He also prayed before making important decisions as well as before His agony of the Cross.

When we spend time alone with Our Lord we should try to unite our will to His. We should seek to be filled with His strength and be guarded from sin and temptation. "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from me; yet, not as I will, but as you will"...

Although there is great power in public prayer, especially the Holy Mass, we need personal prayer to absorb the power of Christ's presence found therein. We simply cannot cultivate a sincere relationship with Christ without personal prayer.

When we do pray in private, Our Lord has taught us to pray for our enemies and those who persecute us (Mt 5, Lk 6). He told us to pray for vocations (Mt 9, Lk 10). He warned us to pray unceasingly (Mk 13, Lk 18, Lk 21). Remember Our Lord told us we would receive whatever we asked in prayer (Mt 21, Mk 11)!
