St. Paul

As a prisoner in Rome, St. Paul was forsaken by all his friends. His death at the hands of the evil ruler Nero was imminent. The faith St. Paul had so courageously fought for was decaying with growing corruption in the Church. Imagine all that St. Paul was able to accomplish since the day he was knocked off his horse when he heard the words of Christ Himself on the road to Damascus!

By the world's standards, Paul had been a failure. He lost all his possessions, he gave up every opportunity for positions of honor, he constantly exposed himself to sorrows, toils and hardships. All the days of his life Paul chose to be a poor man. He lived a solitary life. He was hunted, despised and ridiculed by the Jews and Gentiles. In the end, for all Paul had done in spreading the Truth, his only reward in this life was to be martyred!

In spite of all this Paul remained calm. He waited for his last hour with utter peace of heart. Many martyrs have likewise gone to their horrible deaths with the same calm disposition as St. Paul. We must always be grateful for the holy martyrs who shed their blood for the life of Holy Mother Church! We must pray that we ourselves, when we come to our last hour, will embrace death with the same courage and hope-knowing the heavenly reward that awaits those who have fought the good fight!
