Repentance is a change of mind

The Greek verb for repentance “metanoeo” means to change one's mind. It means to understand things in a new way with a change of view. It means to see things in a different way than before. Parables about repentance are meant to help us see a new way of understanding things.

One of the beautiful things of the parable of the prodigal son is that the father extends his gracious welcome to his son even before the son has a chance to say anything. This parable, as well as the parables of the lost sheep and coin all emphasize repentance as a cause for rejoicing. It is a change of heart that doesn't happen as a result of punishment, shunning or rejection. Rather, it results from the generous and loving care of the shepherd for his lost sheep, of the woman for her lost coin, and of the father for both his sons.

A shepherd cares so much for one lost sheep that he leaves the ninety-nine behind in the wilderness. A woman goes all out to find her lost coin, and then hosts a party that must have cost her more than the coin was worth. A father showers gifts upon his disrespectful and wasteful son, all simply because the boy showed back up. This is how Our Lord works.

God extends His mercy and forgiveness to all who are willing to turn to Him, even to those who do not deserve it...
