“If anyone comes to Me and does not hate father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters-yes, even their own life-such a person cannot be My disciple. And whoever does not carry their cross and follow Me cannot be My disciple.” (Luke 14:26-27).

Our Lord makes it very clear that all relationships must be secondary to following Him. This includes parents, wife or husband, children and even brothers and sisters-none of these can be first in our lives. Every loyalty and every love-even of a disciples's own life-must be less than love for Him. “Whoever does not carry his cross”-whoever will not die to every other loyalty cannot be Christ's disciple!

This means that those who do put Him above all else will find their devotion to Christ risks division and even separation from their families. Jesus said: “From now on there will be five in one family divided against each other, three against two and two against three. They will be divided, father against son and son against father, mother against daughter and daughter against mother, mother in law against daughter in law and daughter in law against mother in law.

Our Lord's words mean discipleship means making hard choices. If we are aware of God's will, there can be only one Master, only one Lord.
